## Introduction

### **1. What is the OpenFamilyServices Directory (OFS) Subject Vocabulary?**

The Subject Vocabulary is a controlled vocabulary that has been created specifically for use by local authorities to classify and tag their Family Services Database records, prior to uploading these to the central OPENFAMILYSERVICES Aggregator (the publishing system for the Directory).

The Vocabulary has been created through extensive consultation with parents, stakeholders and reviews of relevant existing vocabularies such as the Integrated Public Sector Vocabulary (IPSV). This latest version (Version 3) contains a significant number of new terms based on suggestions made by local authorities and providers of parenting services.

The aim is to establish a new Editorial Panel to review the Vocabulary at six-monthly intervals. This Panel will include representatives of local authorities and other stakeholders. As of November 2009, the DfE ISB has adopted the Subject Vocabulary as a new standard for the sector.

### **2. How should the Vocabulary be used?**

The Vocabulary should be used when tagging FSD records prior to their uploading to the central OPENFAMILYSERVICES Aggregator. In most cases, the Vocabulary and mechanism for tagging will be available through FSD vendor systems and some of these offer auto-tagging tools. In a few cases, local authorities have their own bespoke FSDs, in which case it is their responsibility to ensure that the Vocabulary contained within the system is the current version (3).

Tagging records with Vocabulary terms improves the accuracy and usefulness of search results for parents.

### **3. How should the list be interpreted and used?**

This list provides a sorted view of level 3 terms in the OPENFAMILYSERVICES Subject Vocabulary, with their associated hierarchy. If level 2 terms do not have narrower terms, the level 3 is blank. The Vocabulary is polyhierarchical, which means the same term may exist in more than one hierarchy.

The recommended approach is to use level 3 terms in preference to level 2 terms when tagging records.

This can be illustrated using the following sub-section of the vocabulary:

Important points to remember are:

1. If a record is tagged with a level 2 term, such as “Adoption” (which has 17 level 3 “children”), this does *not automatically* associate the record with all of the related level 3 terms. So, wherever possible records should be tagged at the most detailed level.

For example, if a service provides help for finding and reuniting birth parents with their children, the record for that service may be tagged with the specific (level 3) terms:

- Birth parents
- Tracing birth relatives

2. Level 2 terms should only be used where:

- a. there is no level 3 term.

For example, within the “Pregnancy and Maternity” section, “Abortion” has no level 3 terms

- b. if the record or resource to be tagged has an implicitly broader meaning than any of the level 3 terms.

For example, an antenatal service that covers all aspects of antenatal care may be tagged with the level 2 term Antenatal”, while a local self-help service might be more accurately tagged with two of the four the level 3 terms:

- Antenatal clubs
- Antenatal support

3. If a parent searches using a level 2 term, the results will include records tagged with that level 2 term and those tagged with any of its related level 3 terms.

For example, when a record is tagged with the level 3 term “Birth parents”, and a parent searches the Directory using the related level 2 term “Adoption”, the record will be found

4. Records should be tagged with as many terms as apply.

Note that:

- Terms shown in bold have been mapped into the Subject Vocabulary from the IPSV.
- Terms that are new to Version 3 are shown in red.
- Terms that are strikethrough are terms which have been ‘deprecated’ (i.e. archived) in Version 3. They still exist as former terms within the vocabulary but are hidden from use.
